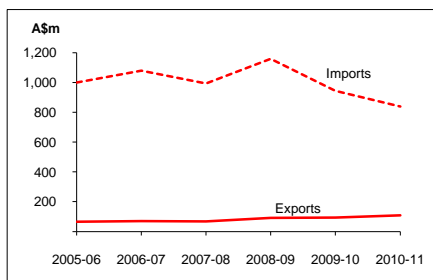

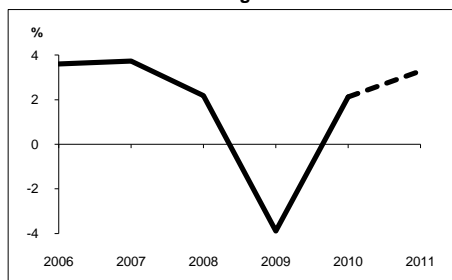

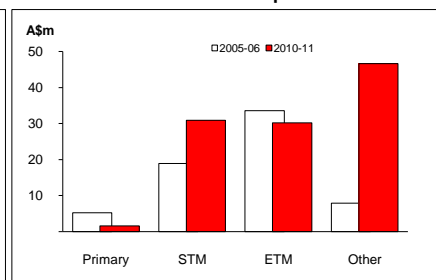
Australia's merchandise trade with Austria
