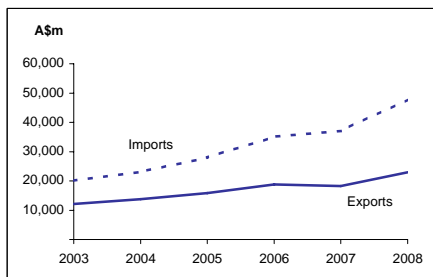

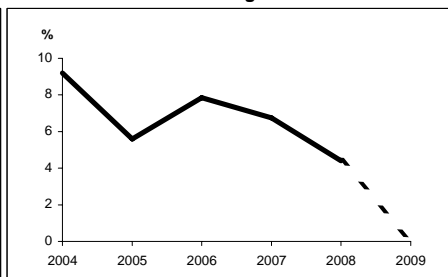

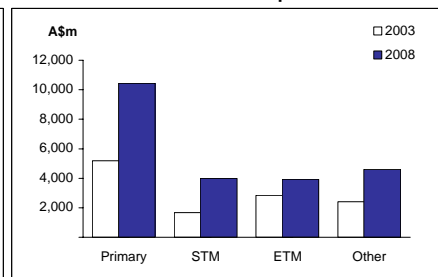
Australia's merchandise trade with ASEAN
