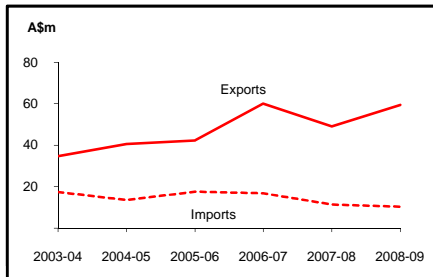

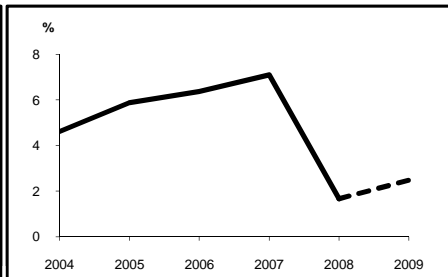

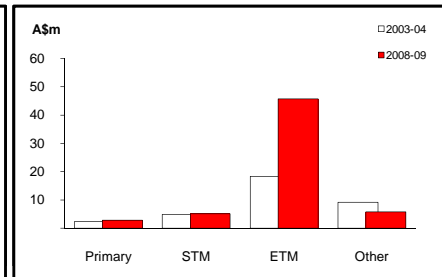
Australia's merchandise trade with Kenya
