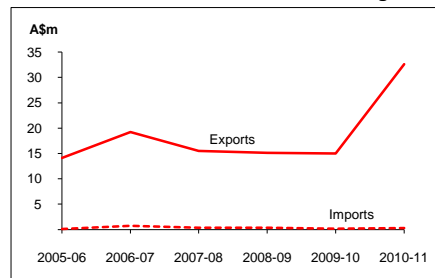

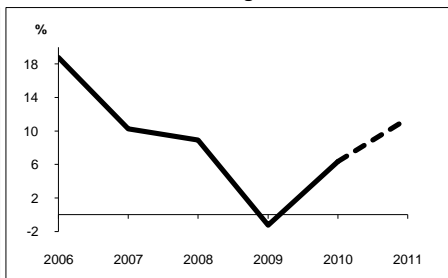

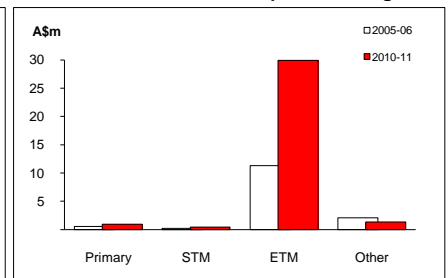
Australia's merchandise trade with Mongolia
