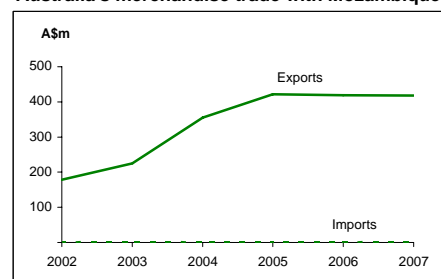

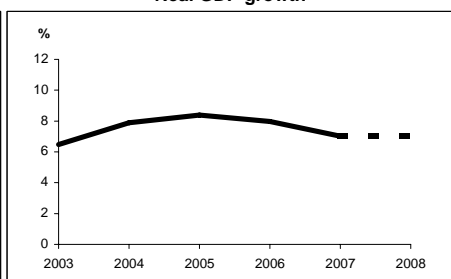

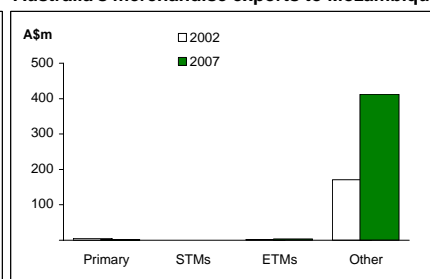
Australia's merchandise trade with Mozambique
