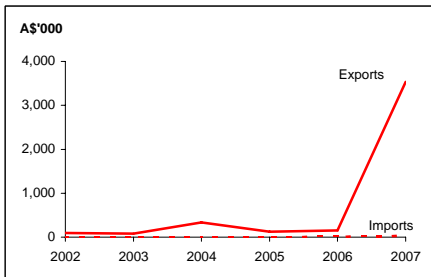

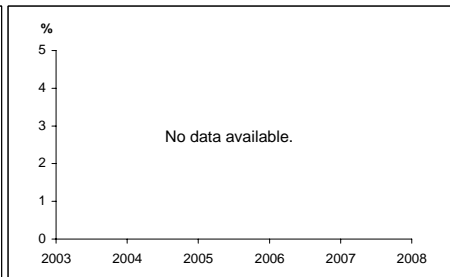

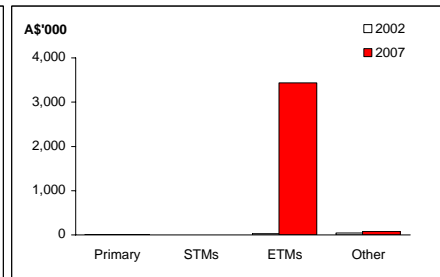
Australia's merchandise trade with Niue
