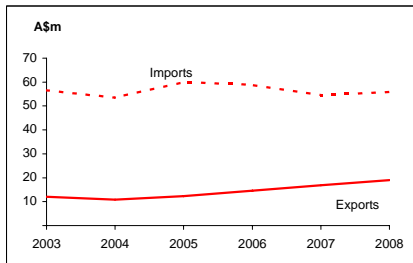

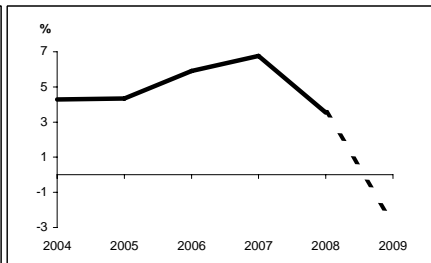

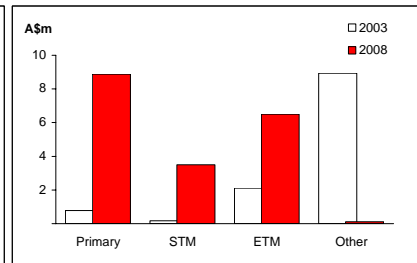
Australia's merchandise trade with Slovenia
