Statement by Australia

14 May 2019

Thank you [President/Vice President]

Australia commends Ethiopia on steps taken to widen the political space and improve gender equity.

However, challenges remain

Australia recommends that Ethiopia:

- 1. Ensures civil and political rights, particularly freedom of association and freedom of expression, are upheld, including ending the practice of internet shutdowns.
- 2. Establish a formal moratorium on the death penalty, as a step towards complete abolition.
- 3. Take measures to reduce the societal stigma faced by LGBTI persons, including repealing provisions in national law that criminalize consensual same sex relations.
- 4. Ensure the treatment of internally displaced persons in accordance with the Guiding Principles on Internal Displacement 1998.
