Universal Periodic Review of the Italian Republic

Statement by Australia

Monday 4 November 2019

Thank you [President/Vice President].

Australia commends measures taken by Italy to improve gender equality, including Act 120/2011, which requires increased representation of women on company boards. We welcome also Italy's increased funding for anti-trafficking projects, and the adoption of its first National Action Plan against Trafficking and Serious Exploitation of Human Beings.

Australia recommends that Italy:

- 1. Takes further measures to address the gender wage gap, noting the prevalence of women in part-time and low-paid jobs.
- 2. Enhances practical implementation of the National Action Plan on Trafficking and takes effective action to ensure that victims of trafficking are treated in accordance with human rights.
- 3. Establishes an independent national human rights institution compliant with the Paris Principles, and strengthens the capacity of the National Office of Racial Discrimination.
