**ANNEX 3-D**

TEXT OF THE STATEMENT ON ORIGIN

A statement on origin, the text of which is set out below, shall be made out using one of the following linguistic versions and in accordance with the law of the exporting Party, or using any other linguistic version notified by the Union. The Union shall notify any other linguistic version of the statement on origin to Australia at the latest on the date of accession of a third country to the Union. If the statement on origin is handwritten, it shall be written in ink in printed characters. The statement on origin must be drawn up in accordance with the respective footnotes. The footnotes do not have to be reproduced.

The exporter of the products covered by this document (Exporter Reference No ... (2)) declares that, except where otherwise clearly indicated, these products are of ... (3) preferential origin.

1. If the statement on origin is completed for multiple shipments of identical originating products within the meaning of Article 3.18 (Statement on origin), indicate the period for which the statement on origin applies. That period shall not exceed 12 months. All importations of the product must occur within the period indicated. Where the statement is completed for a single shipment, the field may be left blank in which case the data field may be omitted.

2. Indicate the reference number through which the exporter is identified. For the Union exporter, this shall be the number assigned in accordance with the laws and regulations of the Union. For the Australian exporter, this shall be the Australian Business Number (ABN). Where the exporter has not been assigned a number or a number is not required, this field may be left blank.
3. Indicate the origin of the product: "Australia" or the "European Union".
4. Place and date may be omitted if the information is contained on the document itself provided that the date is the same.
5. If the field for the Exporter Reference No is left blank (see footnote 2), in addition to the name of the exporter also provide the address details, insofar as this information is not contained on the document itself.
