Humanitarian Partnership Agreement (HPA) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 3- year program - Started 2011 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HPA Steering Committee comprises representatives of AusAID, ACFID and the 6 NGOs selected through competitive process - meets quarterly • A full-time HPA Director funded jointly by AusAID & NGOs and located in Save the Children, some admin support. Provides secretariat to Steering Committee, coordinates implementation and M&E at program level. • Six identical AusAID-NGO funding agreements
Australia Africa Community Engagement Scheme <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 5-year program - Designed 2011 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Joint AusAID / NGO Steering Committee comprises: two from AusAID (one Nairobi, one Canberra), and one each from the 10 accredited NGOs • AusAID tender to select a managing contractor to establish a: • Resource Facility, including a Resource Facility Manager and a small number of support staff , supplemented by technical support contracted as required. Responsible for program coordination, financial oversight, M&E and secretariat for Steering Committee Meetings. Relieves AusAID of day-to-day management.
Solomon Islands NGO Partnership Agreement (SINPA) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 5-year program - Designed 2009 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Six Australian NGOs funded to design and implement one project each in partnership with SI partner NGOs • Steering Committee to manage SINPA- meet quarterly. • A SINPA Facilitator based in one agency to coordinate, and be secretariat to the Committee. • A Livelihoods Reference Group - local partners and other external stakeholders including the Solomon Islands Government
Australia Middle East NGO Cooperation Agreement 2 (AMENCA2) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 5-year program - Designed 2008 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • AusAID Desk and Post jointly provide program level management, coordination, M&E and reporting, and organise annual meetings, contracts • Australian NGOs manage and report at project level • Umbrella agreement signed between AusAID and NGOs • Individual contracts between AusAID and NGOs
