Pursuit of common interest in multilateral fora and the Commonwealth.

Outlook

Export and investment opportunities exist in Antigua and Barbuda for Australian businesses, particularly in tourism and related industries.

Bilateral relations

Australia's High Commissioner to Trinidad and Tobago is accredited to Antigua and Barbuda. Antigua and Barbuda does not have official representation in Australia.

Antigua and Barbuda hosts the headquarters of the West Indies Cricket Board.

Public diplomacy

Through the [Direct Aid Program](#) (DAP), the Australian Government provides financial support to a range of projects in Antigua and Barbuda. Recent DAP projects focussed on helping Barbudan evacuees in Antigua with essential supplies and developing agricultural skills among vulnerable youth.

The Australian Government provided \$500,000 in humanitarian assistance to Antigua and Barbuda through the Red Cross after Hurricane Irma devastated Barbuda in 2017.
