

Australia-Indonesia Partnership Towards an Inclusive Society

Are you a civil society organisation (CSO) in Indonesia working on inclusive development?

AIPTIS is an upcoming partnership program between the Australian and Indonesian Governments to contribute towards inclusive democracy in Indonesia.

Working with civil society, AIPTIS will ensure more Indonesian women, children and minority groups can equitably participate in and benefit from Indonesia's social, political and economic opportunities.

Civil society has played a critical role in Indonesia's democratic and economic reforms over the last two decades including in areas of women's and minority rights, religious tolerance and pluralism. The contribution of CSOs to an effective state is increasingly recognised by the Indonesian Government.

Civil society facilitates community engagement, evidences community needs and program impacts and works in coalition for successful policy reform.

Selection process for the delivery partners

We will undertake a two-stage process to select delivery partners. We will be seeking CSOs with broad networks to identify, plan and manage activities to achieve AIPTIS goals. Selected CSOs will partner with a Facilitating Partner and on-grant to local CSOs to help deliver the program.

How to get involved

Organisations will shortly be invited to provide Expressions of Interest for the AIPTIS program. Required expertise includes one or more of the following:

- gender equality and/or social inclusion
- working from local to national levels
- civil society networks, coalitions and multi-stakeholder engagement
- capacity building, training and support services for CSOs
- evidence based policy advocacy
- data analytics, research and policy advice
