Australia-Indonesia Partnership Towards an Inclusive Society

◆ WHAT IS IT?

AIPTIS is an upcoming partnership program between the Australian and Indonesian Governments to contribute towards inclusive democracy in Indonesia.

Working with civil society, AIPTIS will ensure more women, children and minority groups can benefit from Indonesia's social, political and economic opportunities.

Civil society has played a critical role in Indonesia's democratic and economic reforms over the last two decades including in areas of women's and minority rights, religious tolerance and pluralism. The Indonesian Government increasingly recognises the contribution of civil society to an effective state. Civil society facilitates community engagement, evidences community needs and program impacts, and works in coalition for successful policy reform.

WHAT THE FACILITATING PARTNER WILL DO

The Facilitating Partner will provide overall management of AIPTIS including:

- Convening and supporting civil society partners
- Supporting policy engagement
- Grants and financial management
- Relationship management
- Monitoring, evaluation and learning
- Knowledge management
- Risk management
- Administration

COLLABORATIVE DESIGN

We will leverage stakeholders' expertise to shape the design of AIPTIS and the role of the Facilitating Partner. A stakeholder workshop with shortlisted organisations will seek technical inputs on program priorities and outcomes and approaches to working in partnership with civil society organisations (CSOs).

Through a parallel process, we will select CSO partners to deliver activities to achieve program goals.

SELECTION PROCESS FOR THE FACILITATING PARTNER

We will undertake a two-stage process to select the Facilitating Partner. The selected Facilitating partner will then engage CSO partners, contribute to the final design and mobilise the program by the end 2020.

It is expected this process will open in November 2019 through the AusTender website.
