AUSTRALIA HAS COMMITTED \$10.25 MILLION

This will help **MORE THAN 195,000 PEOPLE** through our humanitarian partners including:

- » Providing access to shelter, sanitation and clean water for **80,000 PEOPLE** through the Indonesian Red Cross
- » Reaching **NEARLY 60,000 PEOPLE** with health, sanitation and hygiene support through Australian NGOs and their local partners.
- » Providing hygiene and reproductive health assistance to **OVER 25,000 WOMEN AND GIRLS** through UN agencies and international and local NGOs
