Australia and the Philippines have a long-standing bilateral relationship. We share common perspectives on many regional, economic and security issues and we cooperate closely in a broad range of areas including defence, law enforcement and development.

Strategic direction

Aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Australia's three strategic objectives in the Philippines are to:

- enhance the foundations for economic growth by investing in infrastructure, aid for trade and education (SDGs 4, 8 & 9);
- build stronger institutions for transparent and accountable governance (SDGs 11, 16 & 17); and
- improve conditions for peace and stability (SDG 4 & 16).

We continue to address the cross-cutting issues of disaster resilience and preparedness, gender equality (SDG 5) and supporting the needs of people with a disability (SDG 10).

Australia expects to award 380 short-term and long-term Australia Awards scholarships in 2020.

Program highlights in 2018-19

- Supported significant progress in reducing clan conflict in the southern Philippines, with sixteen local conflicts formally settled through mediation, improved ceasefire mechanisms, and better communications between communities and police.
- Contributed to the passage of the Universal Health Care law that enrols all Filipinos into the government national health insurance system and provides free primary health services.
- Humanitarian activities supported response to disasters reaching 163,494 people, including assistance for the most vulnerable people affected by Typhoon Mangkhut, the Marawi conflict and recurrent conflict in Mindanao.
- Trained 900 public school teachers, 102 Islamic school teachers and 450 school heads, and rolled out an innovative peace and inclusion curriculum with teachers reporting 32% less violence among students.
