

This will extend the benefits of the international cable beyond Honiara (14 per cent of the population). PM Turnbull and PM Hou would announce the domestic network for the first time during the visit and witness the signing of a landing party agreement between the Commonwealth and the Solomon Islands Submarine Cable Company. The agreement sets out responsibilities of each party in delivering the project.
