THE COST OF THE P-SERIES PASSPORT

The total production cost for the P-series passport is currently AUD\$22.80. This is made up of AUD\$9.02 for an ordinary chip booklet, AUD\$7.95 for a chip (¥625 per unit based on a Budget Exchange Rate (BER) of 678.5965 in 2019-20) and AUD\$5.83 for a laminate (USD\$4.15 per unit based on a BER of USD\$0.7120 in 2019-20). Based on a forecast issuance rate of 2.1m, the total cost amounts to approximately AUD\$47.88m per annum.

The laminate used in the personalisation of the P-series passport costs USD\$4.15 per unit. The move to a polycarbonate data page (with an embedded chip) will eliminate the need for a laminate, and will result in a saving in personalisation costs.

THE COST OF THE R-SERIES PASSPORT

By comparison, the total production cost for the R-series passport is expected to be in the vicinity of AUD\$20.00 per unit, or a total of approximately AUD\$42.000m per annum. The cost for the R-series passport is anticipated to be AUD\$2.80 per unit less than the existing P-series passport.
