# EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Minute No. xx of 2024 - Minister for Foreign Affairs

Subject- The Constitution

Termination of Appointment and Commission of Appointment of Ambassador of Australia to the Kingdom of Belgium

The purpose of this instrument is to make a diplomatic appointment.

The power to appoint Australian diplomatic and consular representatives is exercisable by the Governor-General by virtue of Chapter II of the *Constitution* which provides, among other things, that the executive power of the Commonwealth is vested in the King and His Heirs and successors and is exercisable by the Governor-General.

The Minute recommends the termination of the appointment of Caroline Jane Millar as Ambassador of Australia to the Kingdom of Belgium, from a date to be determined by the Minister for Foreign Affairs, and the appointment of General (Rtd) Angus John Campbell AO, DSC as Ambassador of Australia to the Kingdom of Belgium subject to *agrément* being received from the Kingdom of Belgium. The granting of *agrément* by the receiving State for the person a sending State proposes to accredit as head of mission is a requirement of the *Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations*, to which Australia is a party. The *agrément* of the Kingdom of Belgium will be sought for this appointment. The Ambassador to the Kingdom of Belgium is concurrently accredited to the European Union, the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation and the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg. The Minute also seeks authority for the Minister for Foreign Affairs to determine the salary, allowances and other terms and conditions to apply to this appointment.

General Campbell is expected to take up his position in January 2025, succeeding Ms Millar who has been Ambassador since 2021. Ms Millar will return to Canberra at the completion of her posting and take up a senior position in the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade.

General Campbell was most recently Chief of the Australian Defence Force (2018-2024). He has previously served as Chief of the Australian Army (2015-2018); Commander Joint Agency Taskforce Operation Sovereign Borders, Department of Home Affairs (2013-2015); Deputy Chief of the Australian Army (2012-2013); Major General Middle East Area of Operations, Department of Defence (DoD) (2011-2012); Major General Military Strategic Commitments, DoD (2010-2011); Deputy Secretary and Deputy National Security Adviser, Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (PM&C) (2009-2010); and First Assistant Secretary, Office of National Security, PM&C (2005-2009).

General Campbell holds a Bachelor of Science (Hons), University of New South Wales (1985) and a Master of Philosophy in International Relations, Cambridge University (1993).

General Campbell is suitable for appointment as Ambassador for Australia to the Kingdom of Belgium by virtue of his prior experience and relevant background.

Whilst I am sure that agrément is still a little while away (any ideas?), please find attached drafts of all credentials papers in preparation, for posts review.

Can I please confirm that the NATO letter still needs to be signed by both GG and FM? I have made drafts based on Caroline's papers however there seems to be no finalised signed NATO letter in her file so I am unsure about the requirements.

Letters will be dated by Post beginning of January 2025. For the EU : four signed letters (one letter of credence and one of recall for each European Commission and European Council), dated [blank] January 2025. Awaiting approval agrement from the EU. For Luxembourg : no letters. Awaiting agrement approval. For NATO : no letters. Nomination was approved end of January 2025.



NATO Protocol just advised as follows for the NATO letters of recall and credence :

"Who signs the letters is a national decision on your side. Traditionally these are signed by the Head of State or Government <u>or</u> the Foreign Minister. If in your case these are signed by the Governor-General, that is fine with us.

We have no strict requirement with regards to the wording, so what I saw in the draft letters is perfectly fine to us. One slight tweak, we always use British English **spelling**, except in the name of the <mark>Organization</mark>: THE NORTH ATLANTIC TREATY ORGANI<mark>Z</mark>ATION

*There is no need for separate copies to the Chief of protocol. The originals can be handed over during the courtesy call. That is sufficient for us*"

So the changes to the NATO letters would be 1) the word ORGANI**Z**ATION with a "Z" and 2) only signed by GG and delete Foreign Minister.

### **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

Minute No. 430 of 2024 - Minister for Foreign Affairs

Subject- The Constitution

Termination of Appointment and Commission of Appointment of Ambassador of Australia to the Kingdom of Belgium

The purpose of this instrument is to make a diplomatic appointment.

The power to appoint Australian diplomatic and consular representatives is exercisable by the Governor-General by virtue of Chapter II of the *Constitution* which provides, among other things, that the executive power of the Commonwealth is vested in the King and His Heirs and successors and is exercisable by the Governor-General.

The Minute recommends the termination of the appointment of Ms Caroline Jane Millar as Ambassador of Australia to the Kingdom of Belgium, from a date to be determined by the Minister for Foreign Affairs, and the appointment of General (Rtd) Angus John Campbell AO, DSC as Ambassador of Australia to the Kingdom of Belgium subject to *agrément* being received from the Kingdom of Belgium. The granting of *agrément* by the receiving State for the person a sending State proposes to accredit as head of mission is a requirement of the *Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations*, to which Australia is a party. The *agrément* of the Kingdom of Belgium will be sought for this appointment. The Ambassador to the Kingdom of Belgium is concurrently accredited to the European Union, the North Atlantic Treaty Organisation and the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg. The Minute also seeks authority for the Minister for Foreign Affairs to determine the salary, allowances and other terms and conditions to apply to this appointment.

General Campbell is expected to take up his position in January 2025, succeeding Ms Millar who has been Ambassador since 2021. Ms Millar will return to Canberra at the completion of her posting and take up a senior position in the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade.

General Campbell was most recently Chief of the Australian Defence Force (2018-2024). He has previously served as Chief of the Australian Army (2015-2018); Commander Joint Agency Taskforce Operation Sovereign Borders, Department of Home Affairs (2013-2015); Deputy Chief of the Australian Army (2012-2013); Major General Middle East Area of Operations, Department of Defence (DoD) (2011-2012); Major General Military Strategic Commitments, DoD (2010-2011); Deputy Secretary and Deputy National Security Adviser, Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (PM&C) (2009-2010); and First Assistant Secretary, Office of National Security, PM&C (2005-2009).

General Campbell holds a Bachelor of Science (Hons), University of New South Wales (1985) and a Master of Philosophy in International Relations, Cambridge University (1993).

General Campbell is suitable for appointment as Ambassador for Australia to the Kingdom of Belgium by virtue of his prior experience and relevant background.

#### Background:

I seek your formal agreement to the nomination of Ambassador to the European Union, North Atlantic Treaty Organization, Belgium and Luxembourg (HOM Brussels).

2. The current HOM Brussels, Caroline Millar, is due to conclude her appointment in December 2024.

3. I recommend General Angus Campbell AO, DSM (Rtd) for appointment as the next HOM Brussels. General Campbell (Rtd) recently completed service as Chief of the Australian Defence Force (2018-2024). Prior to this, he was Chief of the Australian Army (2015-2018). He was a career Army officer with an infantry and special forces background. In late 2005, General Campbell (Rtd) was First Assistant Secretary, Office of National Security and subsequently Deputy Secretary and Deputy National Security Adviser at the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet.

4. General Campbell (Rtd) holds a Bachelor of Science (Honours) from the University of New South Wales and a Master of Philosophy in International Relations from Cambridge University. He is also a graduate of the Australian Army Command and Staff College.

5. General Campbell (Rtd) has advised that he is not aware of any personal or professional factors that would affect the acceptability of his appointment to either the Australian Government or the governments to which he would be accredited. Nor is he aware of any personal or professional factors that would affect his appointment to any of the organisations to which he would be accepted.

6. This nomination would change the gender composition of HOM/HOP overseas appointments to add one male.

7. I have provided a letter from you to the Prime Minister setting out this nomination, should you wish to consult with him.

8. Your early approval of this submission will enable the appointment to be considered promptly by the Federal Executive Council.
