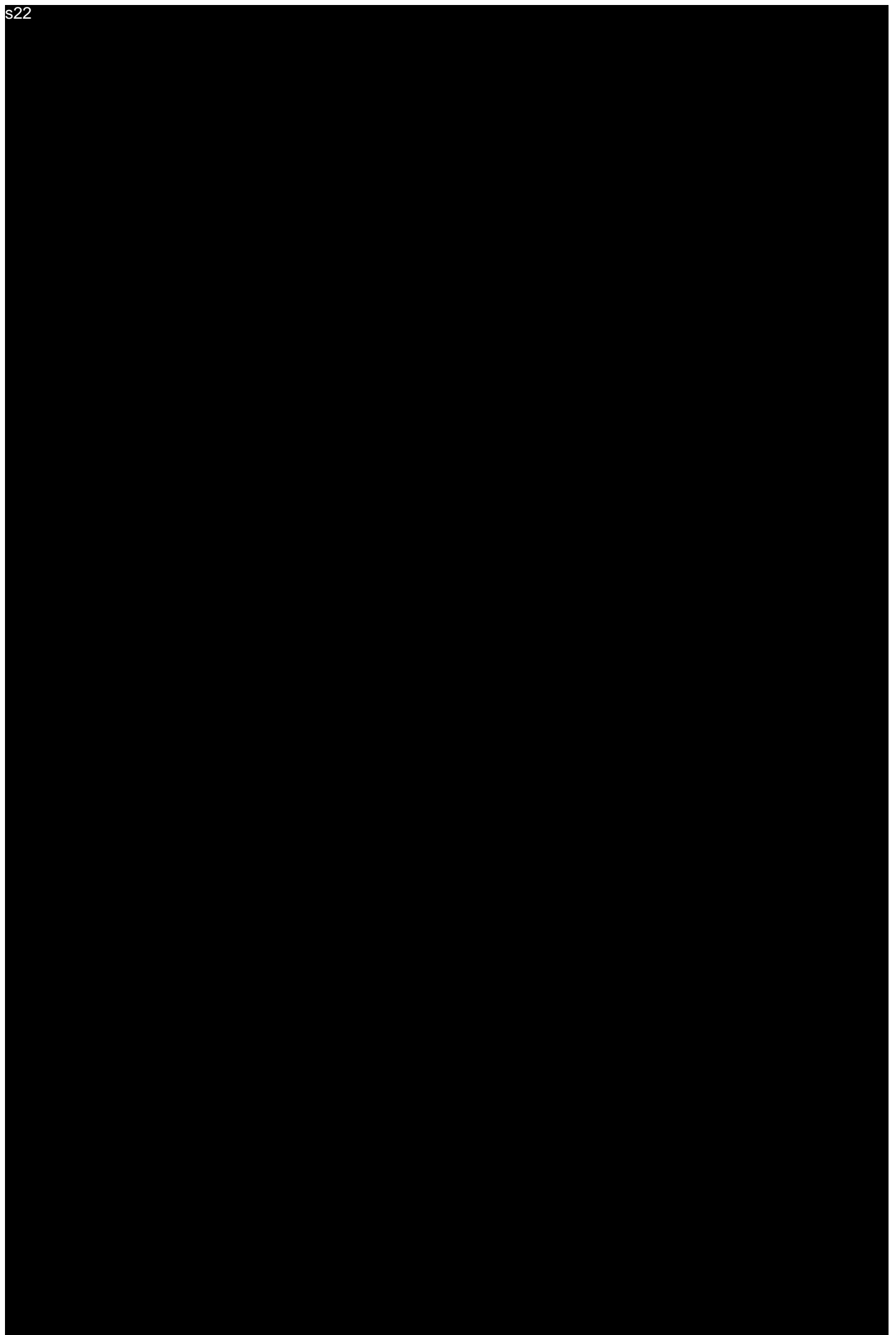


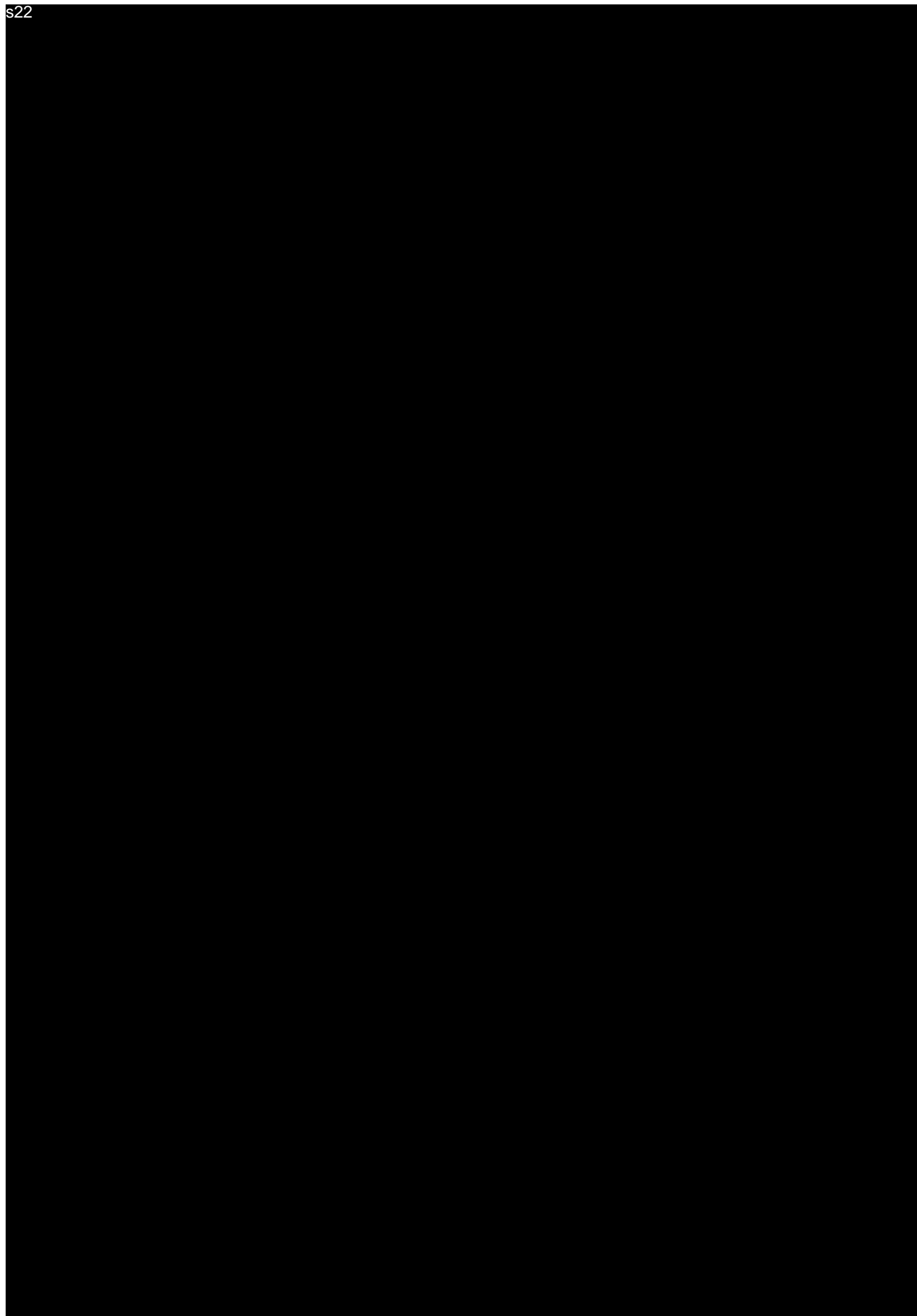


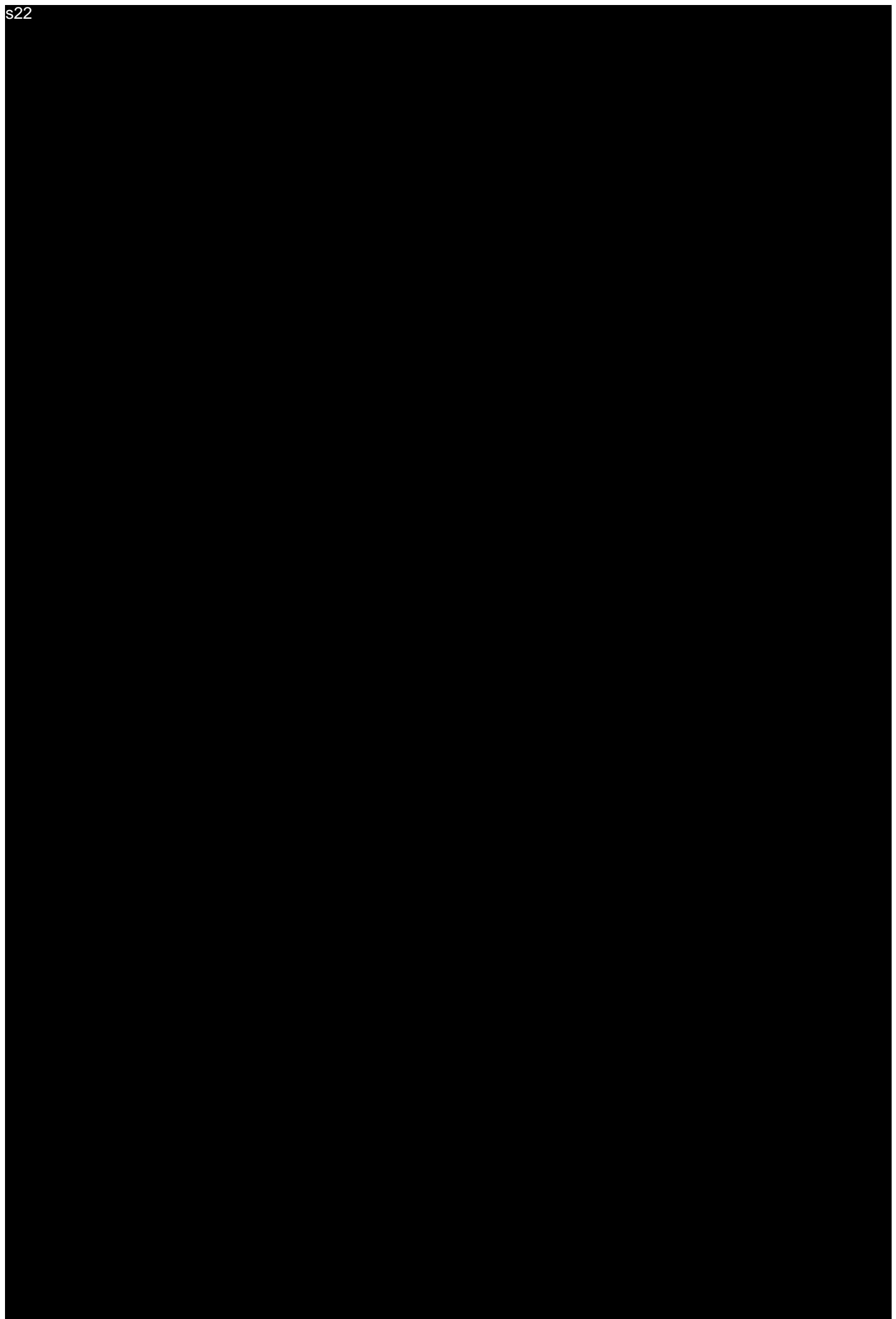


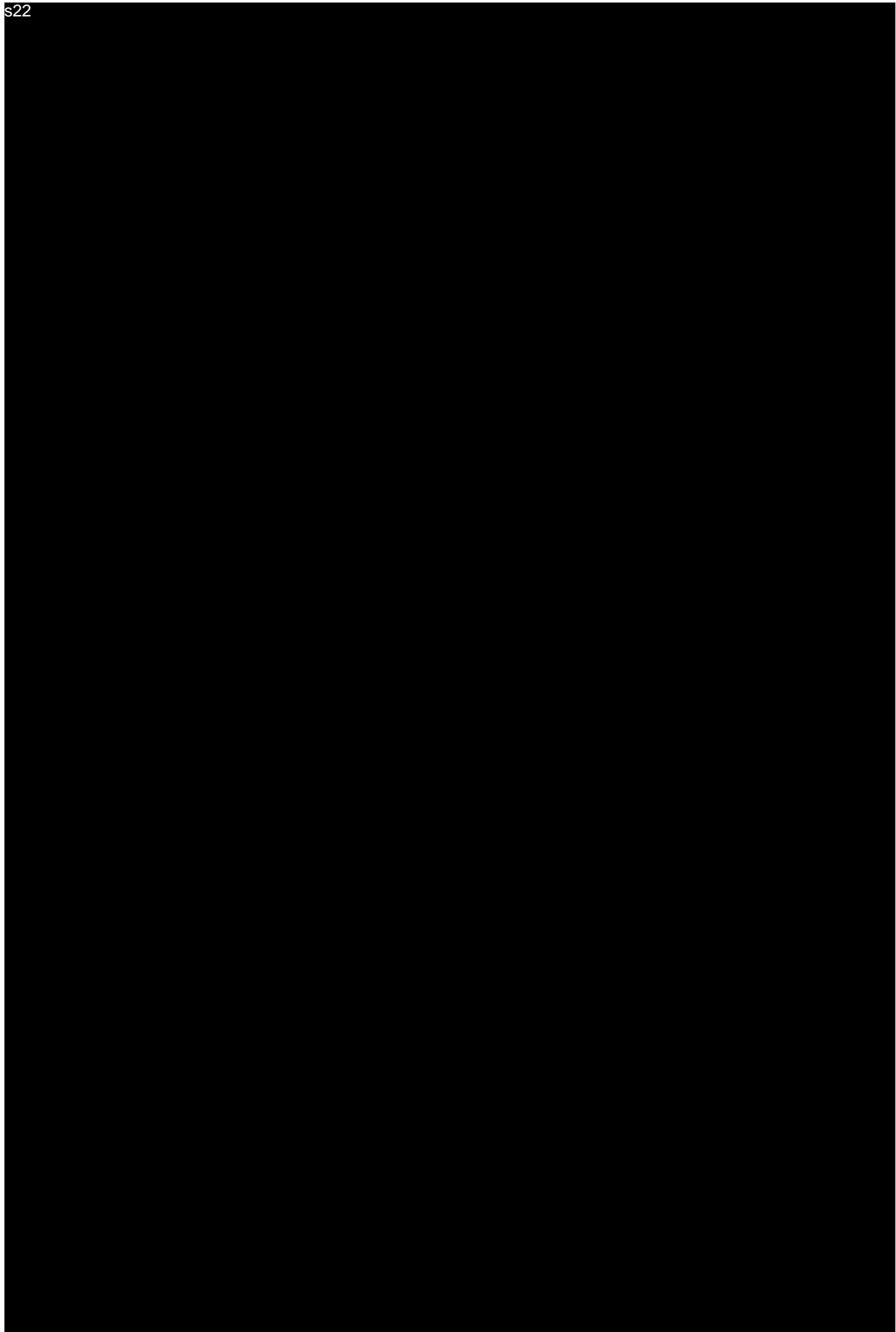




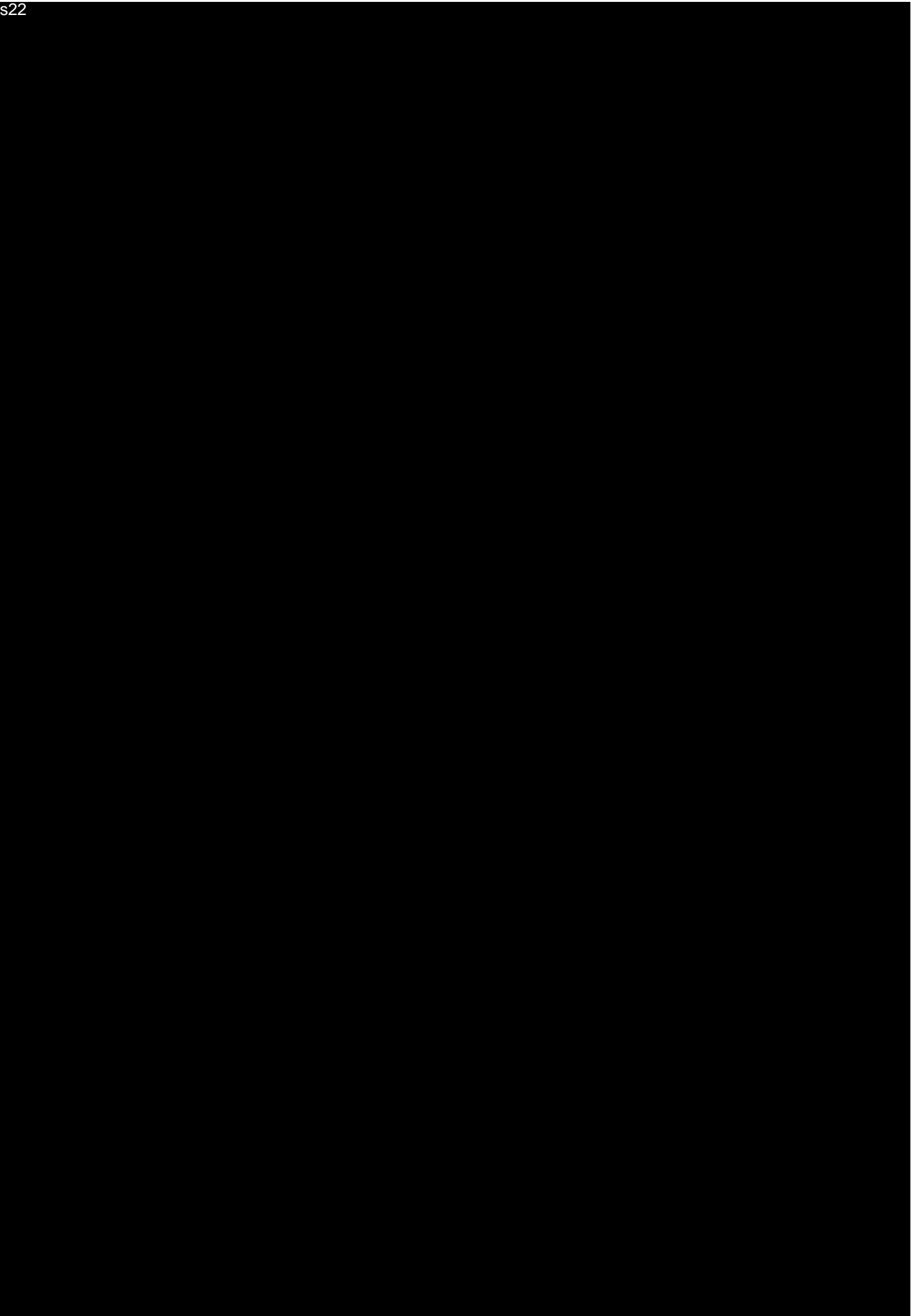








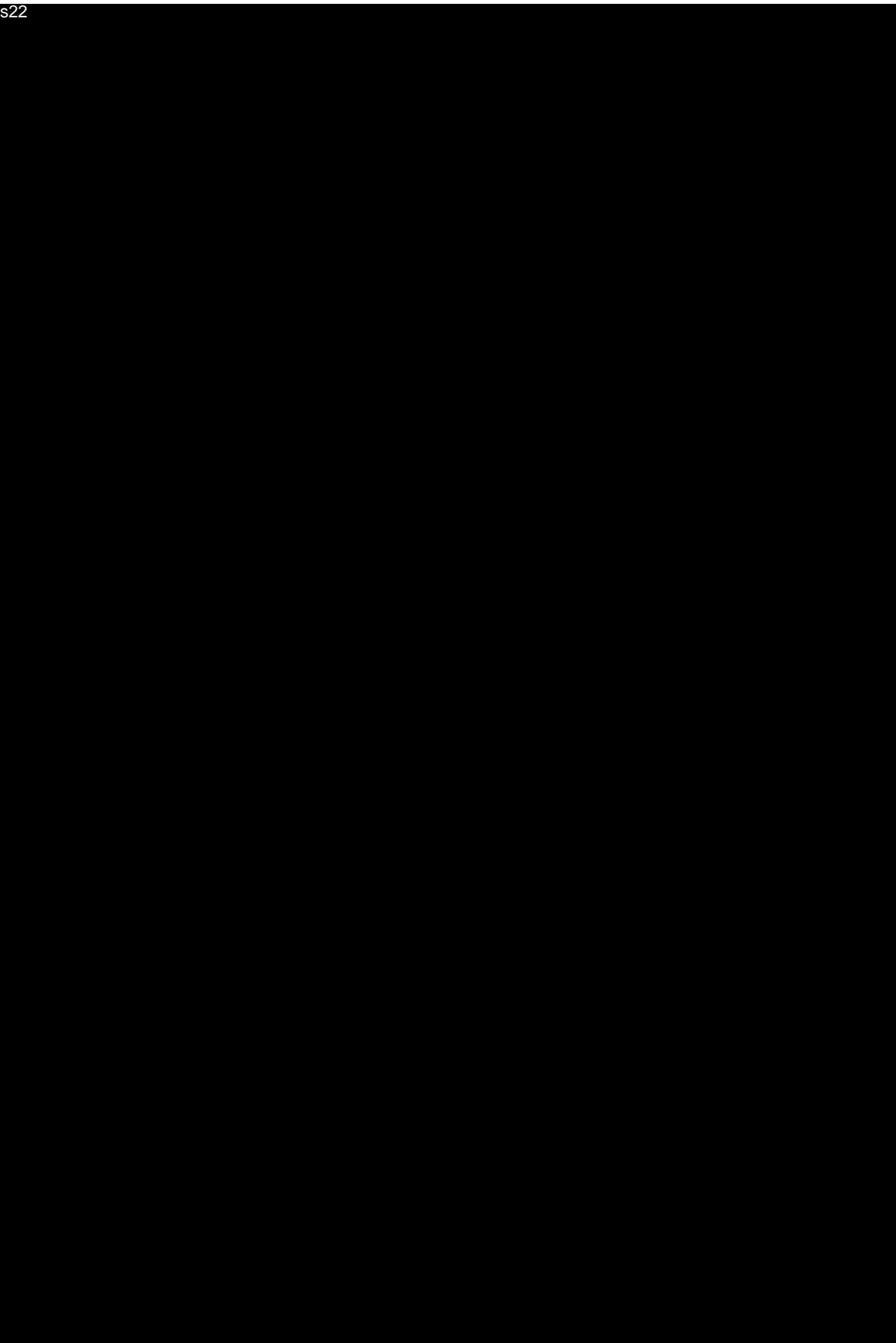


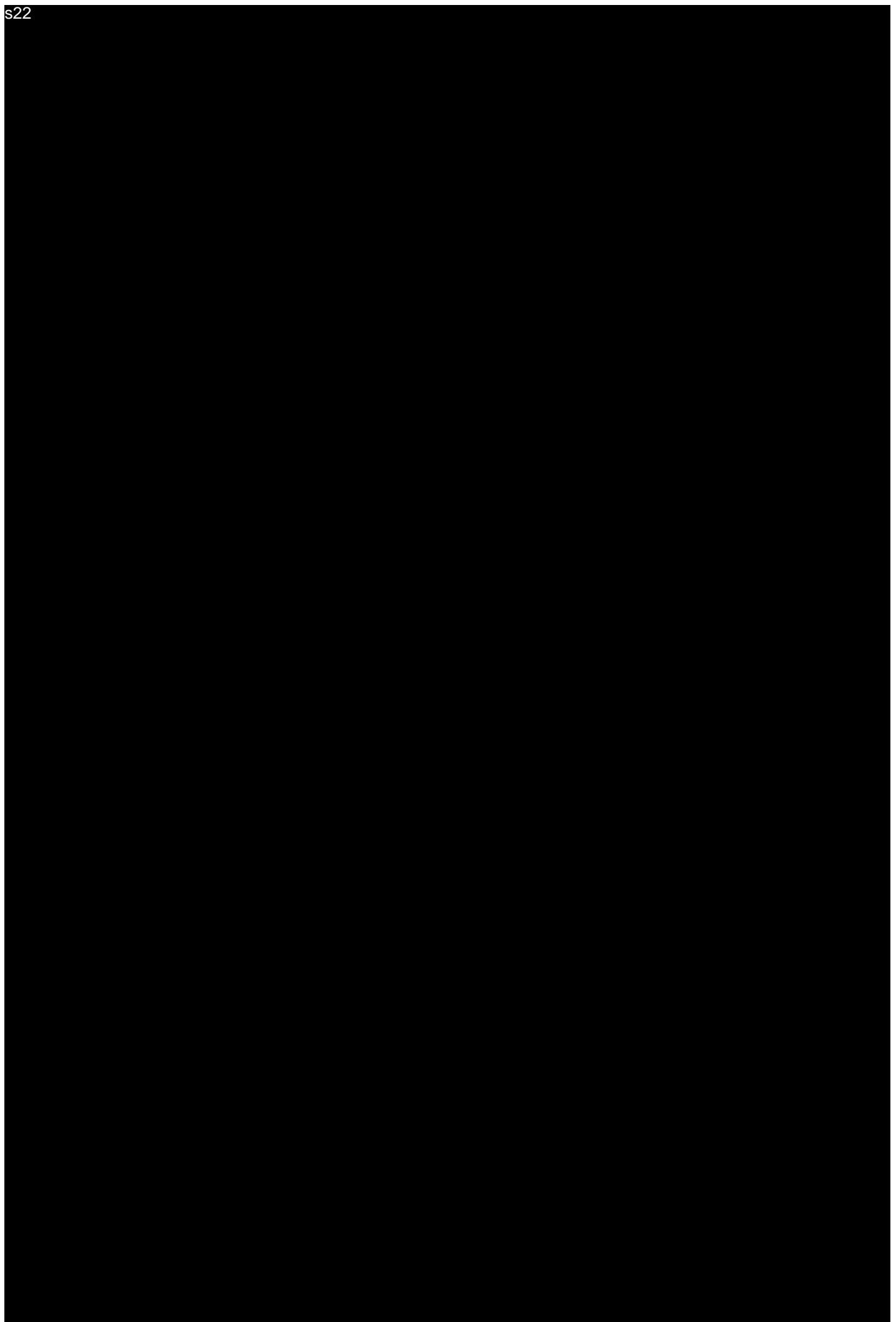




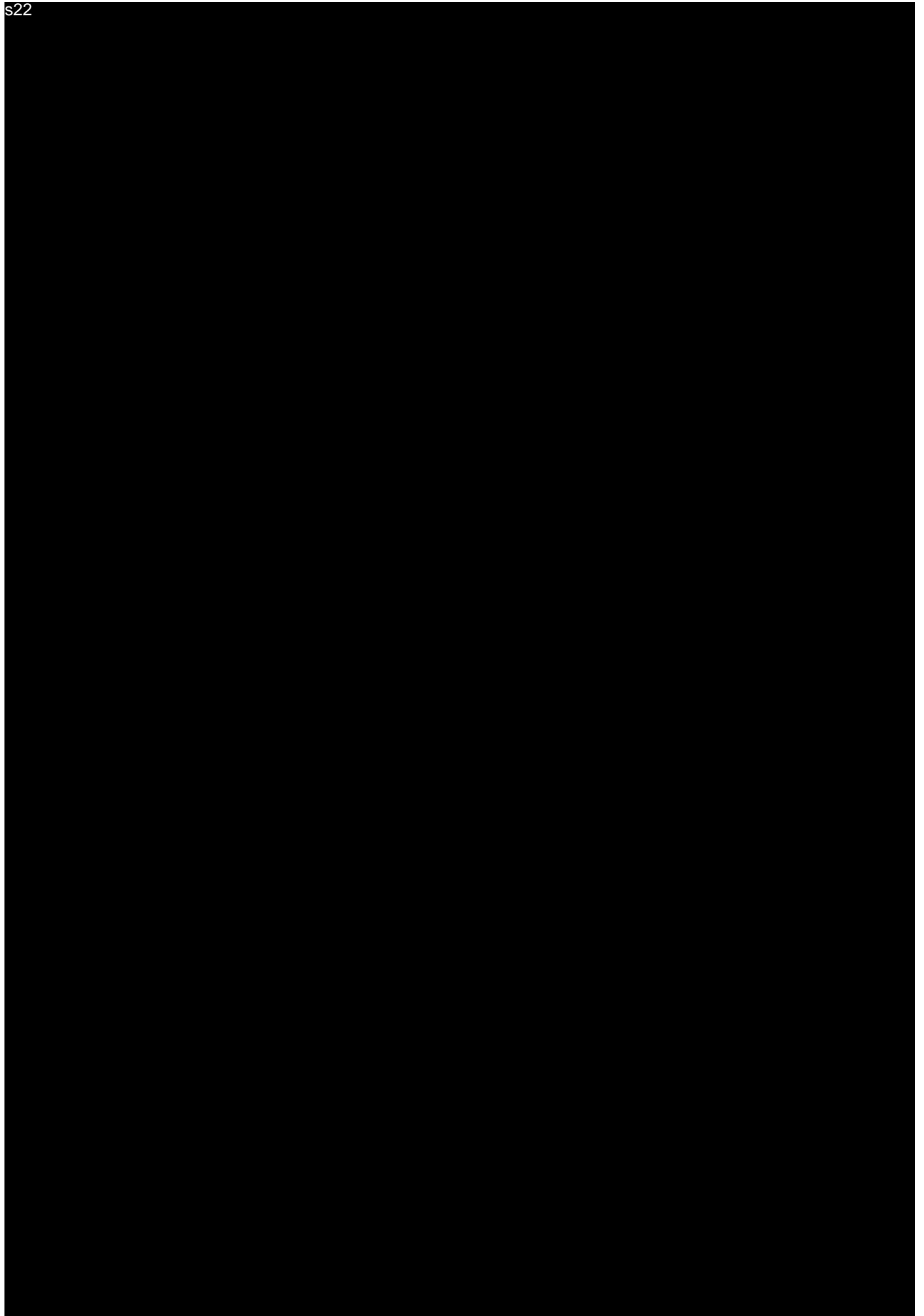




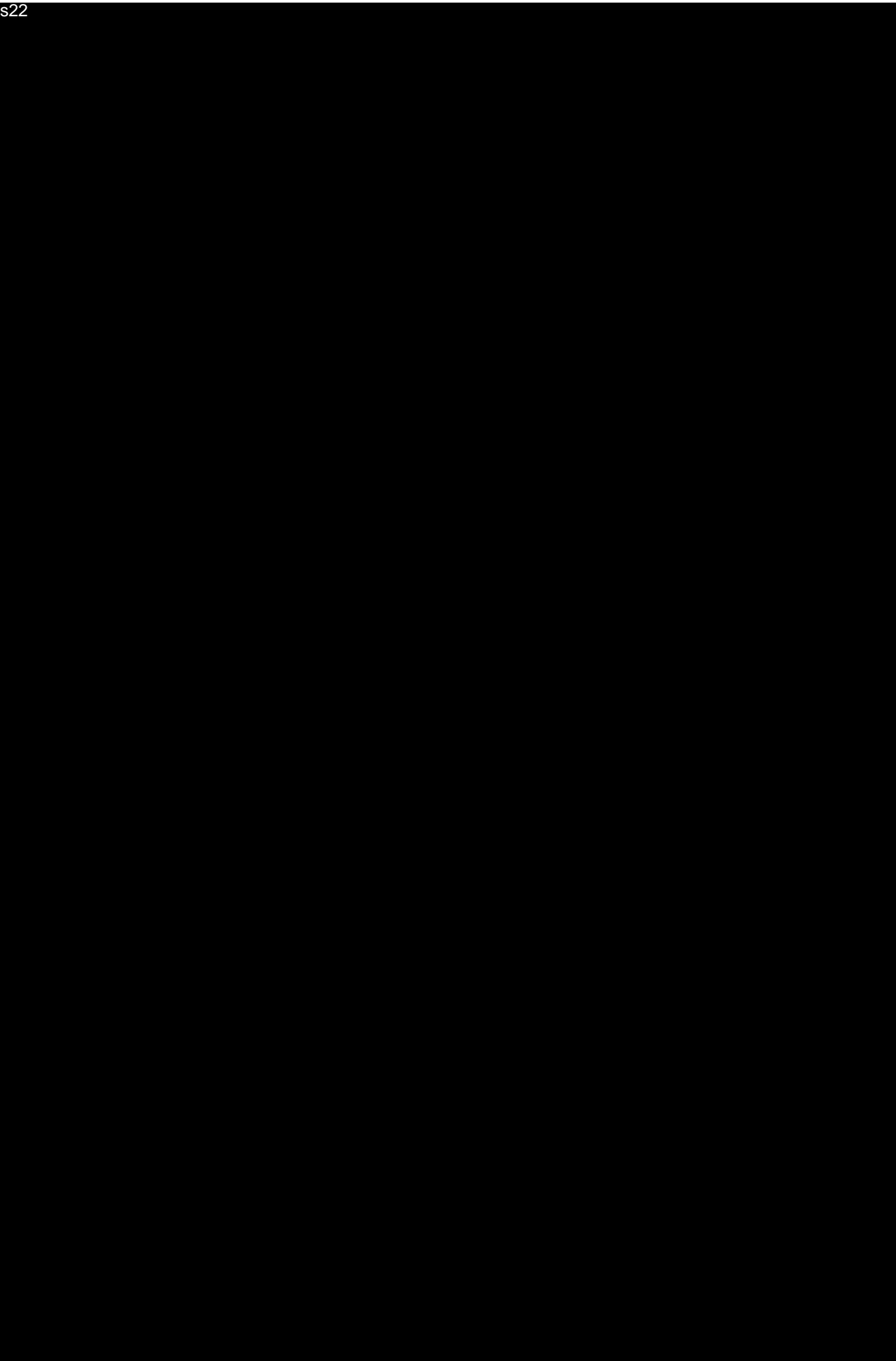












**If asked:** *what will CECA achieve on critical minerals?*
