# Media reporting:

Ms DUTERTE has been the subject of significant media reporting in the Philippines. The most significant recent (since 2024) reporting is included at <u>Attachment A</u>. Australian based media reporting is limited with the most significant reporting outlined below:

#### **OFFICIAL: Sensitive Personal-Privacy**

- On 24 November 2024, ABC Australia reported that Ms DUTERTE had said that she had contracted an assassin to kill President Marcos, his wife and the speaker of the Philippines' House of Representatives if she herself is killed. In response to her comments, the Presidential Security Command said it had heightened and strengthened security protocols.
- On 6 February 2025, The Guardian reported that Ms DUTERTE had been impeached on a range of accusations that include plotting to assassinate the president, large-scale corruption and failing to strongly denounce China's aggressive actions against Filipino forces in the disputed South China Sea. Ms DUTERTE didn't immediately comment on her impeachment, but her brother, Representative Paolo Duterte, said it was "a clear act of political persecution."

#### On 19 June 2025 SBS Filipino reported that:

- O Human rights advocates raise concerns over VP Sara Duterte's visit to Melbourne. The podcast noted that A "peace rally" in support of former Philippine President Rodrigo Duterte is set to take place this Sunday in Melbourne. However, the event is drawing criticism from several Filipino-Australian groups and human rights advocates who are voicing strong opposition to the expected attendance of Vice President Sara Duterte and Senator Imee Marcos. Human rights advocates raise concerns over VP Sara Duterte's visit to Melbourne | SBS Filipino
- Over 3,000 expected at Melbourne peace rally with VP Sara Duterte in attendance. The podcast noted that Vice President Sara Duterte, along with Senators Imee Marcos and Robin Padilla, is expected to attend the rally, which is projected to draw over 3,000 supporters. Open source reporting suggests that, Ms DUTERTE's impeachment trial is scheduled to commence in June 2025. The Department sought confirmation from DFAT, who has been unable to confirm these reports.

#### Significant Filipino based media since 2024

On 24 January 2024, the Inquirer reported that the testimony of a confessed hit man for the Davao Death Squad (DDS) served as the main basis for the inclusion of Ms DUTERTE as a "secondary" respondent in a crimes against humanity case before the International Criminal Court (ICC). Reportedly, the retired police officer implicated Ms DUTERTE as having had a role in extrajudicial killings, when she took over the mayoral duties in 2010 from her father and "agreed to continue" the "tokhang" approach. However, Ms DUTERTE has disputed these claims, stating that not once during her term as Davao City Mayor and Vice Mayor was she linked with the DDS.

On 8 March 2024, Philstar Global reported that Ms DUTERTE believes that she has been targeted by an "organized demolition job" based on the escalation of personal attacks against her online as well as the public's reaction to her push for confidential funds last year. In a statement, Ms DUTERTE said recent "attacks" meant to ruin her reputation have become more "intense, severe and desperate" and these aim to frame her as a "killer" or "someone corrupt, abusive, traitorous and a war lord".

On 18 September 2024, the Philippine News Agency reported that Ms DUTERTE had asserted that there was "no misuse of funds" as she faced a congressional inquiry on her office's budget utilisation. During the hearing conducted by the House Committee on Good Government and Public Accountability, Ms DUTERTE maintained that the Office of the Vice President had done nothing wrong, stating "There is no misuse of funds. If there are audit findings, we shall gladly respond to them before the Commission on Audit. And if there are legitimate cases to be filed, then we shall gladly respond to them before the appropriate courts".

On 19 October 2024, the Inquirer reported that Ms DUTERTE had said that she had warned the family of President Marcos that she would dig up the body of their patriarch, Ferdinand Marcos Sr, and dump it into the sea if they continued to attack her. Reportedly, Ms DUTERTE stated "I told Senator Imee (Marcos), if you don't stop, I will dig the grave of your father and I will throw him to the WPS (West Philippine Sea). One of these days, I will really go there and get his body".

On 24 November 2024, the Sunstar reported that Ms DUTERTE clarified her statement regarding her instruction to have President Marcos, First Lady and House Speaker assassinated in the event of her death. In an interview, Ms DUTERTE said she was not threatening the Marcos' and Romualdez, stressing that she only made the statement to highlight the serious threats to her own life.

On 29 November 2024, the Office of the President of the Philippines reported that President Marcos stood firm that he does not support calls for the impeachment of Ms DUTERTE, as it would not benefit the Filipino people, stating "This is not important. This does not make any difference to even one single Filipino life. So, why waste time on this?"

On 2 December 2024, the Philippines News Agency reported that an impeachment complaint had been made against Ms DUTERTE. The complaint details 24 articles of impeachment and cited culpable violation of the constitution, graft and corruption, bribery, betrayal of public trust, and other high crimes as grounds for impeachment.
