## Update on Appointment of Australia's Special Envoy to Combat Antisemitism

- 5. Ambassador for Human Rights (Moules) and DFAT official s 22(1)(a)(ii) joined a 25 June follow up meeting between Home Affairs and the SEAS (Deputy Special Envoy Aaron Keyak and Victoria Bonasera).
- 6. Home Affairs noted that the announcement of the appointment of the Special Envoy to Combat Antisemitism was imminent and will report directly to the Prime Minister and Minister for Immigration, Citizenship and Multicultural Affairs.
- 7. Home Affairs advised that the prospective Envoy received the guidelines independently and broadly supported its utility in respect to combatting Antisemitism and fostering social cohesion in Australia. Home Affairs suggested the Special Envoy would likely attend the launch of the guidelines in Bueno Aires on 17 July (with their flights already booked).
