NSW Government's international footprint

- NSW Government has a small international footprint relative to some other states, with a strategic focus on aligning with Austrade services. NSW Commissioners are co-located with Austrade in seven of their priority markets.
- Engagement in Southeast Asia has expanded from a focus on Singapore, Malaysia and Indonesia to a broader regional outlook encompassing all ASEAN countries. NSW developed an ASEAN strategy to coincide with the March 2018 Australia-ASEAN Special Summit in Sydney.
