On 28 July, Chargé Roberts will host an investiture ceremony for Dr Haruhisa HANDA at the HOM residence. In May, Handa was appointed an honorary member in the General Division of the Order of Australia for his service to the arts, education and sport through philanthropic contributions (see attached). Handa is a businessman and philanthropist with a significant profile in Japan.

2. Handa was originally planning to receive his award in Australia but his travel plans changed and instead he requested for the investiture ceremony to be held at Post in Tokyo. In light of the recent increase in COVID cases, we have limited the invite list for the event to 30 external guests. The ceremony will coincide with a meeting of prominent international political figures held under the auspices of Handa's organisation, Worldwide Support for Development, which will be held in Tokyo across a number of days.
