# PEOPLE'S LIBERATION ARMY-NAVY INCIDENT IN EAST CHINA SEA

### **REACTIVE ONLY - CORRECT AS AT 16 NOVEMBER 2023**

### **Background (NOT FOR PUBLIC RELEASE)**

- On Tuesday 14 November 2023, HMAS Toowoomba experienced an unsafe and unprofessional interaction with a People's Liberation Army-Navy (PLA-N) destroyer. Toowoomba was stopped in the water to conduct diving operations in the East China Sea, in order to clear fishing nets that had become entangled around its propellers.
- HMAS Toowoomba was in international waters inside Japan's Exclusive Economic Zone and this activity is routine for an Australian ship operating in the region.
- HMAS Toowoomba was operating in support of Operation ARGOS, the Australian Defence Force (ADF) commitment to the international effort to enforce United Nations Security Council sanctions on North Korea.
- Toowoomba advised the PLA-N destroyer via all normal maritime communications channels that diving operations were being conducted and requested the vessel remain outside a range of 3 nautical miles (5.5kms).
- Despite acknowledging *Toowoomba*'s communications, the destroyer closed to a range of 1.3 nautical miles (2.4kms).
- Toowoomba again requested the destroyer remain no closer than 2 nautical miles. After acknowledging Toowoomba's request, the destroyer closed to a range of 1580 yards (1.4kms).
- While diving operations were under way when the PLA-N destroyer was at a range of 2400 yards (2.2km), *Toowoomba* detected acoustic transmissions, correlated to the PLA-N destroyer's hull-mounted sonar.
- Following the incident, divers reported mild headaches and eardrum irritation and received appropriate medical care and treatment. One diver has been diagnosed with mild (grade 2) aural barotrauma. Current medical advice indicates no long-term health impacts are expected.
- The interaction is assessed as unsafe and unprofessional conduct for mariners due to the Chinese warship repeatedly closing inside the requested range, and operating sonar with clear knowledge that there were divers in the water with disregard for their safety.



### **Contingency Talking Points**

- I can confirm on 14 November 2023, HMAS *Toowoomba* and crew experienced unsafe and unprofessional conduct by a Chinese warship in an encounter in the East China Sea.
- HMAS Toowoomba had been conducting operations in support of United Nations sanctions enforcement in international waters. It had stopped in the water to conduct diving operations in order to clear fishing nets that had become entangled around its propellers.
- During this routine operation, a People's Liberation Army-Navy warship approached HMAS *Toowoomba*.
- The Australian vessel was in international waters outside of China's Exclusive Economic Zone and communicated its intention to conduct diving operations on normal maritime channels, and using internationally recognised signals.
- Despite acknowledging the Australian ship's communications, the Chinese vessel approached at closer range than requested, and operated its hullmounted sonar in a manner that posed a risk to the safety of the Australian divers in the water.
- The Australian divers exited the water and the Chinese warship's conduct ceased a short time later.
- Australian divers have received appropriate medical assessment and care, and no long-term health effects are expected.
- The Australian Defence Force assesses this conduct as unsafe and unprofessional, and falls short of standards expected of professional mariners.
- The Australian Government will take appropriate action to raise its concerns regarding this incident with the Government of China.
- I will not be commenting any further at this stage.

### If Asked [OFFICIAL on release]

### Was the Chinese vessel's interaction with HMAS *Toowoomba* professional?

Defence has assessed the interaction as unsafe and unprofessional.



- The PLA-N ship acknowledged a request by the Australian ship to remain at a safe distance but later moved to a closer distance.
- The use of the PLA-N ship's Sound Navigation and Ranging (SONAR) device in close proximity to divers resulted in temporary health effects to our personnel. Defence is supporting our personnel as they recover.

### Why was a PLA-N ship near HMAS Toowoomba?

- HMAS Toowoomba was operating in the East China Sea within the Exclusive Economic Zone of Japan as part of an enduring commitment to Operation ARGOS, Australia's commitment to enforcing United Nations Security Council Sanctions against North Korea.
- The PLA-N ship was shadowing HMAS Toowoomba.
- It is routine for PLA-Navy vessels to shadow movements of Royal Australian Navy vessels in the South China and East China Seas.

#### What is an acoustic transmission?

• In this situation, acoustic transmission refers to the use of SONAR devices, which are used to identify objects under the water.

### Why is a SONAR a danger to divers?

• The medical effects from sonar relate to the effect of noise and associated pressure waves and their impact. The effects can include dizziness or vertigo during the dive, hearing damage, blurred vision, light headedness, vibrations in hands impairing motor tasks, tremors, abdominal pain related to the vibration of gas bubbles. There is a theoretical risk of bubble growth contributing to Decompression Illness if they were to destabilise.

### Is it normal for ships to stop to untangle fishing nets?

 As part of routine propeller and hull maintenance, the divers were clearing fishing nets from the hull of the warship.

### What type of Chinese warship was it?

It was a PLA-N Sovremenny-class destroyer (DDG 139).

### **Supplementary talking points**

### HMAS Toowoomba - PLA-N maritime incident in the East China Sea

- The Australian Government is seriously concerned about ongoing unsafe and unprofessional incidents by China at sea and in the air
  - including an incident on 14 November 2023 while the HMAS Toowoomba was in Japan's EEZ enroute to a scheduled port visit
  - when HMAS Toowoomba stopped to clear fishing nets from its propellers, a
    PLA-N destroyer disregarded requests to stay clear, approached to a close range
    and operated hull-mounted sonar in a manner that posed a risk to the safety of
    the Australian, who were forced to exit the water
  - this kind of behaviour endangers safety, security and creates risks of miscalculation.
- The Australian Government raised its serious concerns directly with the Government of the People's Republic of China, and more broadly through a statement by the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Defence, the Hon. Richard Marles MP.
- As Mr Marles said, "Australia expects all countries, including China, to operate their militaries in a professional and safe manner.
- Australian vessels and aircraft will continue to contribute to UN sanctions
  enforcement operations in the East China Sea, and exercise freedom of navigation and
  overflight in the South China Sea, as we have done for decades
  - we will continue to act in our national interest to support a region which is stable, secure and respectful of sovereignty.
- Australia wants to see a peaceful Indo-Pacific, where international law is respected and adhered to, and waterways are open for trade
  - our actions are guided by our desire to support our partners, enhance maritime security and uphold international law.
- It is vital Australia, India and our partners call out behaviour that is dangerous and inconsistent with international law, particularly the UN Convention on the Law of the Sea.

### **Background**

On Tuesday 14 November 2023, HMAS *Toowoomba* experienced an unsafe and unprofessional interaction with a People's Liberation Army-Navy (PLA-N) destroyer. *Toowoomba* was stopped in the water to conduct diving operations in the East China Sea, in order to clear fishing nets that had become entangled around its propellers.

HMAS *Toowoomba* was in international waters inside Japan's Exclusive Economic Zone and this activity is routine for an Australian ship operating in the region.

HMAS *Toowoomba* was operating in support of Operation ARGOS, the Australian Defence Force (ADF) commitment to the international effort to enforce United Nations Security Council sanctions on North Korea.

Toowoomba advised the PLA-N destroyer via all normal maritime communications channels that diving operations were being conducted and requested the vessel remain outside a range of 3 nautical miles (5.5kms).

Despite acknowledging *Toowoomba*'s communications, the destroyer closed to a range of 1.3 nautical miles (2.4kms).

Toowoomba again requested the destroyer remain no closer than 2 nautical miles. After acknowledging Toowoomba's request, the destroyer closed to a range of 1580 yards (1.4kms).

While diving operations were under way when the PLA-N destroyer was at a range of 2400 yards (2.2km), *Toowoomba* detected acoustic transmissions, correlated to the PLA-N destroyer's hull-mounted sonar.

Following the incident, divers reported mild headaches and eardrum irritation and received appropriate medical care and treatment. One diver has been diagnosed with mild (grade 2) aural barotrauma. Current medical advice indicates no long-term health impacts are expected.

Defence assessed the incident as unsafe and unprofessional conduct for mariners due to the Chinese warship repeatedly closing inside the requested range, and operating sonar with clear knowledge that there were divers in the water with disregard for their safety.



# People's Liberation Army Incident in the East China Sea – 14 November 2023

### Talking points

- On the afternoon of Tuesday 14 November 2023, HMAS Toowoomba experienced an unsafe and unprofessional interaction with People's Liberation Army-Navy (PLA-N) destroyer DDG 139 in the East China Sea, \$ 33(a)(i)
- Toowoomba was stopped in the water to conduct diving operations in order to clear fishing nets that had become entangled around its propellers.
  - HMAS Toowoomba was operating in support of Operation ARGOS, the Australian Defence Force's (ADF) commitment to the international effort to enforce United Nations Security Council sanctions on North Korea.
  - Approximately 150 nautical miles (NM) from Chinese territorial waters at coordinates 30 43N, 126 27E.
- DDG 139 had been shadowing HMAS Toowoomba at this time.
- HMAS Toowoomba advised DDG 139 s 33(a)(i)

her intentions to conduct diving operations and requested DDG 139 remain clear by 3nm.

- o DDG 139 acknowledged the message, but then closed to 1.3nm.
- HMAS Toowoomba again advised DDG 139s 33(a)(i)

of her intentions to conduct diving operations and requested DDG 139 remain clear by 2nm.

- DDG 139 acknowledged the message, but closed further to within 1580 yards (0.8nm).
- DDG 139 proceeded to radiate SONAR, with clear knowledge that HMAS Toowoomba had divers in the water.
- This was dangerous and threatened the safety of our personnel.

Defence \$ 47E(d) have advised that unsafe and unprofessional conduct by a Chinese naval destroyer resulted in an incident with HMAS Toowoomba (HMAS T) in the East China Sea on 14 November.

The incident occurred after the HMAS Toowoomba stopped to clear fishing nets that had become entangled in its propeller. When stopping, HMAS T sent our radio messages and raised flags that it was stopping, not in control (ie moving forward), and that divers would be removing the nets. The radio messages were sent as a general broadcast and also directed to the Chinese destroyer tailing HMAS T. The Chinese destroyer acknowledged the radio message, but did not slow down, closed the distance to HMAS T as close as 1500 yards and also used sonar.

Please see below for your records a summary of our conversation with Defence today (15 November 2023) regarding an unsafe and unprofessional interaction between the ADF and the PLAN (most of this information is also included **below**):

- An incident took place yesterday in the East China Sea between a PLAN destroyer and HMAS Toowoomba, as the HMAS Toowoomba was transiting to Japan on a port visit.
- HMAS Toowoomba stopped to untangle fishing nets in its bow.
- HMAS Toowoomba was being tracked by a PLAN destroyer HMAS Toowoomba asked that the PLAN destroyer stand down as the vessel was no longer underway.
- The PLAN destroyer received and acknowledged the call of the HMAS Toowoomba, however it did not slow down, closed in at close range (within 1500 yards) and deployed active sonar.
