- IIEP will use the contribution: (i) for support to IIEP's permanent tasks and core planning and management within the framework of the IIEP Medium-Term Plan. on Education For All and strengthening of institutional capacity in educational activities (grant-in-aid) and (ii) for support to inter-regional and regional programmes
