

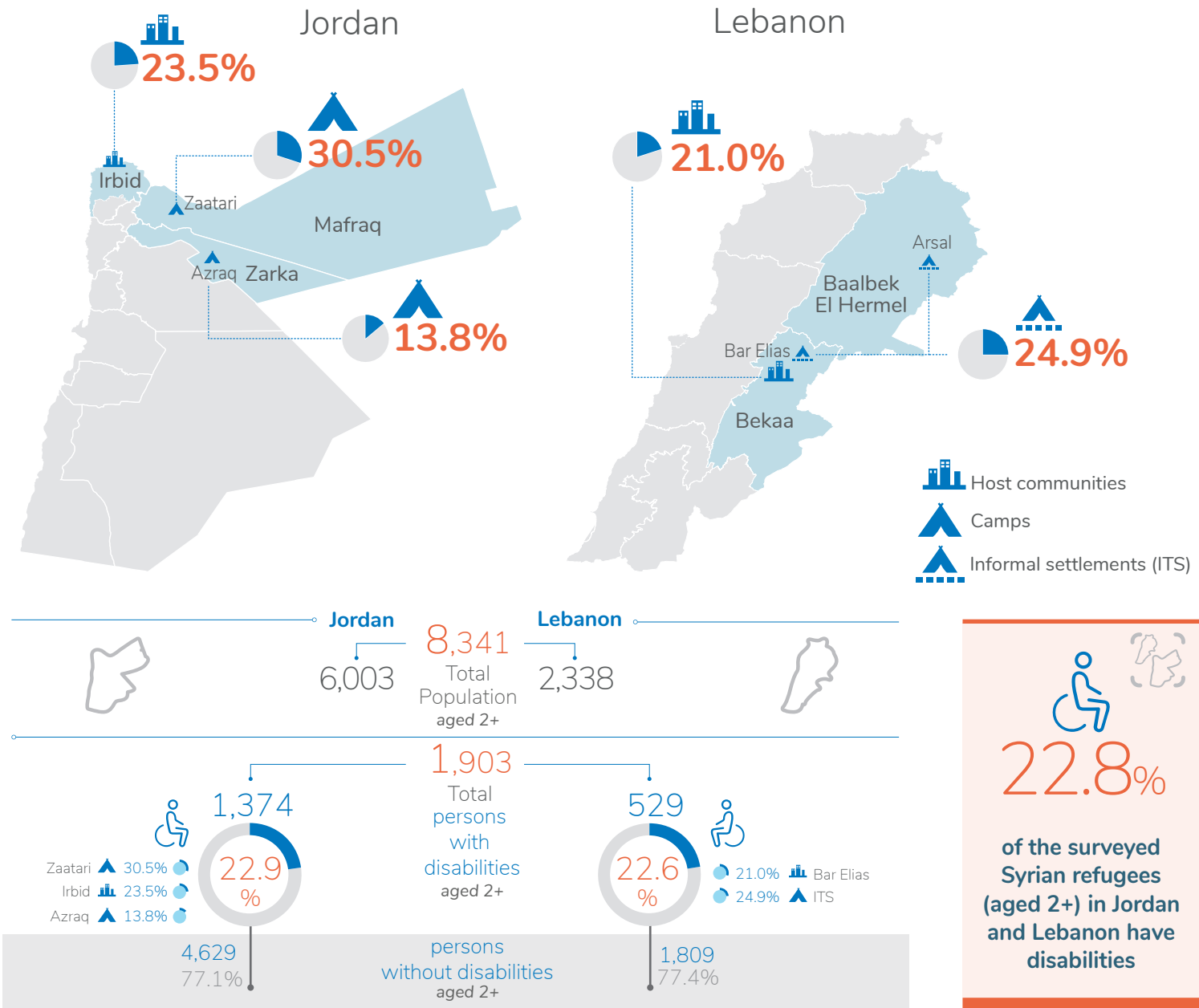

Demographics and Disability

Disability is defined as interactions between personal and environmental factors. It is measured by the level of functioning of a person in various areas of daily activities (called “domains”) regardless of impairments, using the Washington Group tools.

DISABILITY PREVALENCE BY AGE AND GENDER

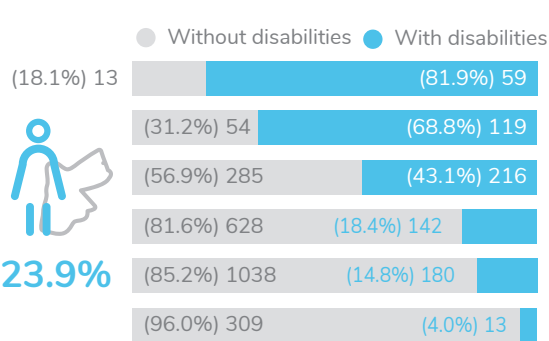
“ Disability prevalence is higher in young males than females in age groups 2-34 years, and in older females than males in age groups 35 years and above ”



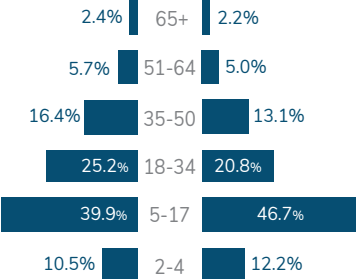

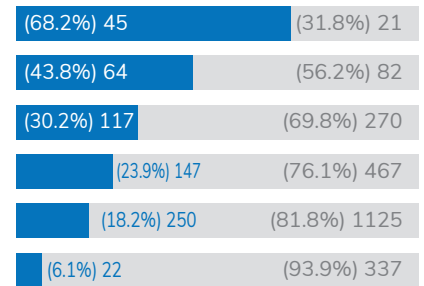

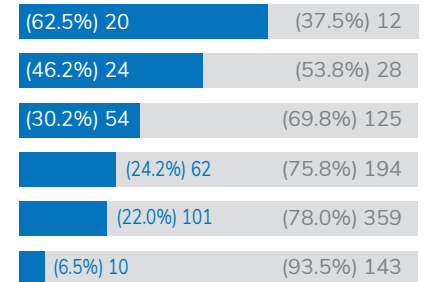
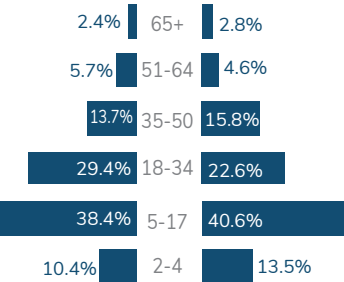
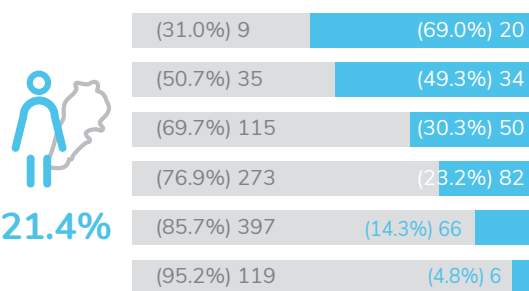
Age distribution in the surveyed population aged 2+ *



With disabilities Without disabilities



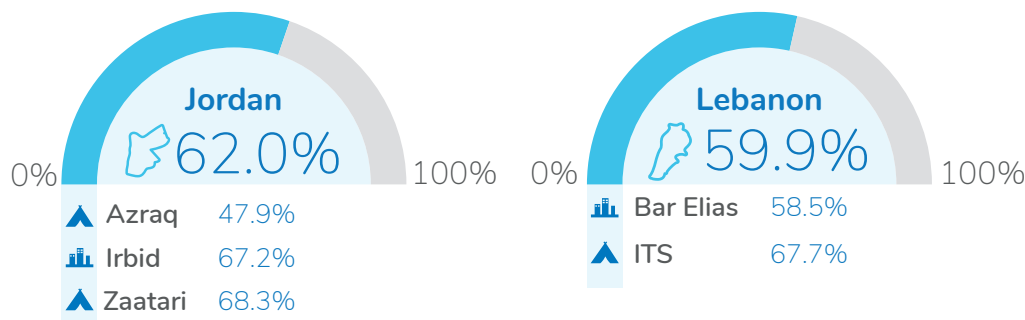

DISABILITY AT HOUSEHOLD LEVEL

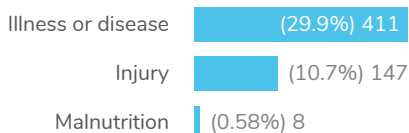
Percentage of households with at least one member with disabilities



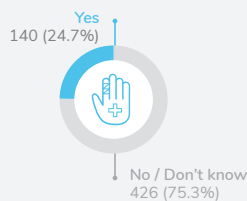
61.4% of households in Jordan and Lebanon have at least one member with disabilities

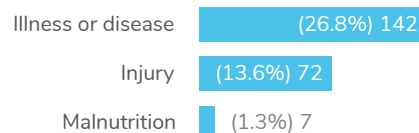

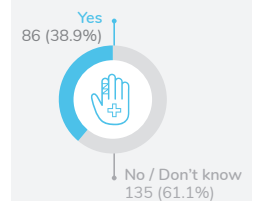

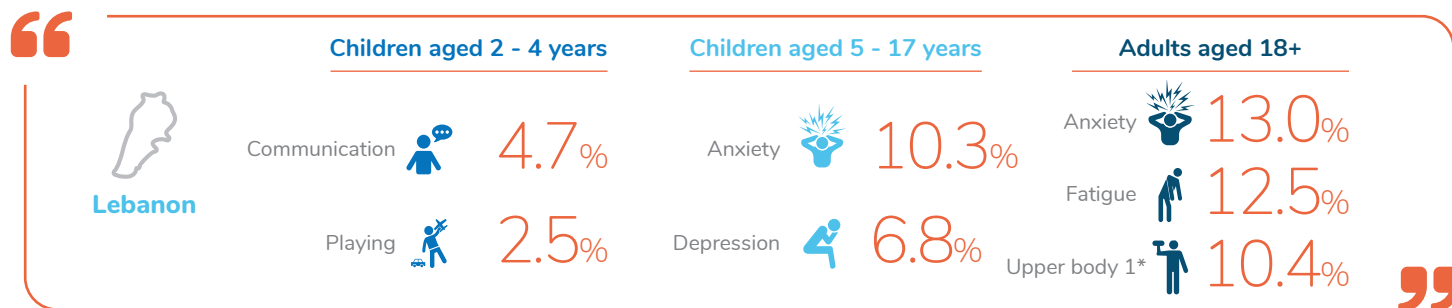
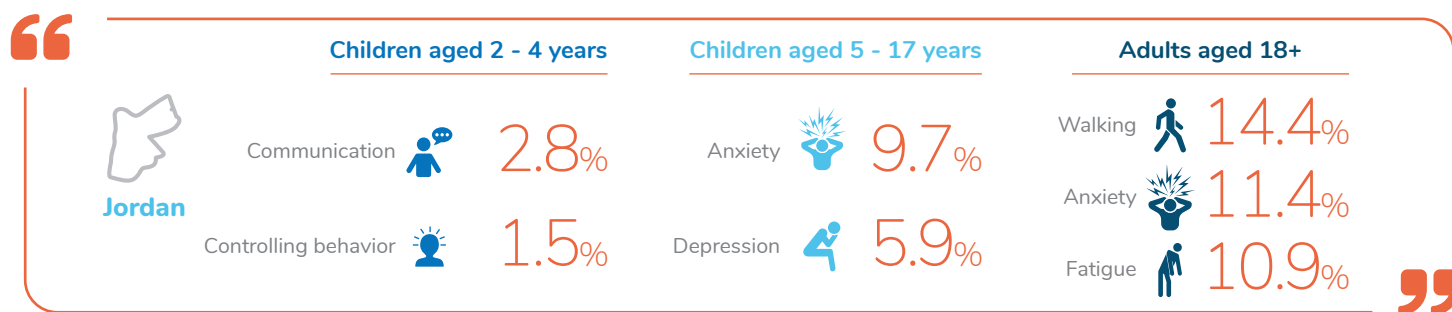


“ Almost one in three disabilities were acquired as a result of illness or disease ”
