Key Messages

Management Response

AusAID agrees with all the IPR recommendations, namely:

1. LOGICA2 is to be extended for another two years (from July 2012 to June 2014). The main focus of the extension period would be the consolidation of best practices in line with the preparation for the new Decentralisation Policy Support Facility to be established by early 2014. The Facility will be used to enable AusAID to be more responsive in supporting GoI and Sub-national Governments to address emerging decentralisation policy issues in Indonesia.
