Dear Sir / Madam,

This is just a short submission to request that as an Australian citizen with strong ancestral ties to two EU member countries, specifically Ireland and the U.K. Who would like to see a greater right for Australian citizens to work, live, study and travel in the EU. I would therefore like to see the following items included in any future free trade agreement between Australia and the EU:

1. Freedom of movement and right to live, work, study and travel unrestricted in all EU member countries for all Australian citizens.
2. Reciprocal health cover and social welfare and agreements between the EU and Australia
3. Unrestricted and tariff free access, for all Australian businesses to be able to trade freely with the EU.
4. Uniform reduction of hurdles and paperwork, for Australian citizens to access citizenship of EU countries, where it can be established they have an extended ancestral link with an EU member country. Specifically allowing for Australians who have great great grandparents or great grandparents, to be able to apply for and receive citizenship from that specific EU member country.
