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RE: CANADA - EXPRESSION OF INTEREST IN JOINING TPP NEGOTIATIONS

We are grateful for the opportunity provided by the Department to comment on Canada's expression of interest in joining the Trans-Pacific Partnership ('TPP') negotiations.
